Here is what has been happening at music class during our first few weeks of the school year . . .

The students are working at "keeping the beat" using rhythm instruments, learning to adjust the pace to tempo changes during large motor fun, matching pitch as we sing fun songs (that their parents grew up singing), and taking turns "directing" - starting and stopping unexpectedly - so we REALLY have to watch the director! The students direct from the balcony near the Fruit of the Spirit tree. Within the tree is hidden "the banana" (which is NOT a Fruit of the Spirit and has to be found and removed). We also have a "Band", in which our 4K group excels!

Families will be receiving a song book with all the songs the students are learning PLUS the scriptures sung to the same tunes! The K, 1st and 2nd graders have begun piano lessons, listening and learning about Mozart, Beethoven, Aaron Copeland, Prokofiev, Strauss, Grieg and Paul Desmond. We have made playdoh figures that we find in our featured "Famous Paintings". Mrs. Ahlgren has read poetry and brief bios about the composers and artists. So, we are very busy in a JOYOUS way!
